

Utah Preschool Immunization Requirements

Utah law requires children attending this Early Childhood Program or facility are appropriately immunized for their age against the following vaccine-preventable diseases:

MINIMUM Preschool Requirements:

4 doses DTaP (or DTP, DT)

3 doses Polio

1 dose MMR (given after the first birthday)

Hib series appropriate for age (at least one dose after 1 year of age)

Pneumococcal series (PCV13) appropriate for age (at least one dose after 1 year of age)

3 doses Hepatitis B (HBV) (last dose after 6 months of age)

2 doses Hepatitis A (HAV) (minimum 6 months apart)

1 dose Varicella (chickenpox) OR If history of chickenpox disease,

parent must sign verification statement in chickenpox box on Pink

Immunization Record.

TB (Tuberculosis) test: IF born outside of the United States

It is your responsibility to have your child immunized and to provide this facility with a medically verified, date and dose specific immunization record for all required immunizations he/she has received. This is required for admission to this facility.

*Students who do not have the required immunizations CANNOT attend until immunizations are up-to-date. Some students may be allowed to attend "Conditionally" if they are in the process of receiving required immunization, but need to wait sufficient spacing intervals between required doses.

*Personal Exemptions can be obtain at the Utah County Health Department in the immunization clinic or a Medical Exemption can be obtained from the student's doctor.

Parents: Fill out top portion of Pink Immunization Record and all immunization dates in the appropriate boxes. Make a copy the child's Official Immunization Records and attach to the Pink Immunization record for nurse verification. Immunizations **MUST be **COMPLETE** and on file at the school before student can begin attending preschool.**
