#4 Reading Books

Choose colorful books with large, simple pictures. Make up your own simple version using a phrase or short sentence (depending on the talking level of your child) for each picture-rather than actually reading what is written on the page. Point out the action in the picture and the things you talk about. Also, remember that a young child's attention span is much shorter than that of an older child's. You may have to keep turning the pages at a faster rate when "reading" to a young child.
