~Help Me Talk Tips~

#6 Parallel Talk

Talk <u>out-loud</u> about what is happening to your child. Use words that describe what <u>he</u> is doing, seeing, hearing, or feeling when your child is <u>nearby or within hearing range</u>. Again, he does <u>not</u> have to be close to you or pay attention to you when you talk out-loud; he only has to be within hearing range Be sure to use slow, clear, simple words and short phrases.
