## ~Help Me Talk Tips~

### #7 Reinforcement (Praise)

Respond quickly to your child's speech attempts and verbal requests by your actions and/or verbal responses. Your non-verbal praise (actions) can include a smile, a hug, a pat on the back, eye contact, clapping your hands, etc. Your verbal praise can include modeling back to your child what he said or just letting him know you like what he said. For example, your child says "ba" for ball the first time, you might open your eyes wide, smile, and then say, "ball-ball rolls-I like your talking."
