#9 Expectations

Your expectations, according to the level your child is at, are very important. You must always let your child know your expectations concerning his speech. If he has said a word or phrase on his own (spontaneously) a few times already, and then doesn't use it again in the same or similar situation, make your child aware that he's not saying something which you know he can say and you expect him to keep using that word or phrase.
